## 355. BREEZE

In a wood 17 people gather in a close group.

Person #1 whispers a phrase to person 2, who whispers their own phrase to person 3. This repeats until all 17 are whispering their own phrase to the person next to them.

Each individual phrase is repeated by each individual person until everyone is saying their own phrase to themselves.

Although they are using words, these aren't discernable, and the noise being made is little more than a breeze through leaves.

The phrase must be in the context of something that calms and pleases each person (eg "I love ...", a favourite lyric etc)

Let this continue for a period until each person has instilled a quiet reassurance within themselves.

Each person can stop whenever they choose, but they must wait in the group until the last person has stopped whispering.
